

## Service Overview

Effective September 1<sup>st</sup>, all residents living in one, two and three unit dwellings in the Village of Hartville will be provided trash and recycling collection services by Republic Services. Residents can choose between two different service levels.

Each resident will be automatically enrolled at the unlimited service level. If a resident would prefer to have the low-volume bag service, they will be required to call the customer service office in Massillon (1-800-247-3644) to change their service level.

**Unlimited Service-** includes a 96-gallon cart for trash and a 65-gallon cart for recycling. Residents will be provided a blue 96 gallon cart for trash and a green 65-gallon cart for recycling. Residents choosing this service can place an unlimited amount of material at the curb. Items not fitting in your cart should be secured and placed at the curb in close proximity to the trash cart.

**Low-Volume Service-** There also is a "Low-Volume" Service available for residents that generate minimal quantities of trash. This is a great service for Sr. Citizens, singles and people that are very effective at recycling. Residents choosing this service will purchase Republic Services trash bags from local vendors for \$2.00 per bag (in rolls of 10 bags). The cost of the bag includes the collection service. So, as you fill your trash bags, place them at the curb for collection. Residents choosing this service will purchase Republic Services trash bags from Hartville Elevator or Giant Eagle.

**Recycling Service-** Residents on the Low-Volume Service that wish to recycle can subscribe to the recycling service. Upon signing up for this service, residents will be provided a green 65-gallon recycling cart. As the cart is filled, simply place it at the curb on collection day. You will be invoiced "quarterly" for the weekly recycling service.

Your Mayor and Village Council have secured firm pricing for you for 3 years.

Republic Services will be delivering carts to the residents the last couple weeks of August. Please begin using Republic carts effective September 1st.

We can provide temporary rental containers for Construction Debris, excess yard waste/leaves, and appliances containing refrigerants or appliances that have not been tagged as having refrigerants removed, as well as any items requiring additional manpower to load or requiring a separate truck or equipment. ## Comprehensive Waste Collection and Recycling Services

**Billing-** All residents will be invoiced quarterly/in advance. Payment terms are 45 days before they are suspended for non-payment.

**Customer Service-** Residents with questions can contact us at 1-800-247-3644 between the hours of 7-5, Monday through Friday. On Holiday weeks where collection days are delayed, the offices will be staffed on Saturday from 8 am to 12 pm to answer any questions that arise.

**Yard Waste-** Republic Services will collect leaves, grass clippings and other vegetation mixed in with your regular weekly trash from residents with high volume service. You can also place it in bags, cans or bundles providing the cans have a bottom that is a smaller diameter than the top. Also, boxes should be dry and bundles should be no more than 4' in length and securely tied in manageable sizes. No individual item should weigh more than 45 pounds. Residents on Low Volume Service should place yard waste in their Republic Services bags. Otherwise, you will be charged for extra bas, boxes, or bundles.

**Collection Schedule-** Residents will be required to have their waste at the curb by 7:00 AM on Mondays with holiday exceptions.

**\*Holiday Schedule-** We will be closed on six major holidays:

- NEW YEARS DAY
- MEMORIAL DAY
- INDEPENDENCE DAY
- LABOR DAY
- THANKSGIVING DAY
- CHRISTMAS DAY

**96-gallon carts-** Unlimited customers will receive a blue 96-gallon cart for their trash and a green 65-gallon cart for recycling. Residents on the "Low-Volume Bag Service" will also be able to subscribe to Recycling Service. They will be provided a 65-gallon cart and invoiced quarterly at the rate provided in the contract.

**Temporary Containers-** Customers can rent commercial or industrial containers for cleanup and construction projects. Standard container delivery, collection and disposal charges will apply.

**Items Not Collected-** We will not collect ashes, drums, hazardous waste, oil, paint, solvent liquids, medical waste, flammable and toxic waste, tires, large batteries, dead animals, large car parts, rocks, bricks, stone, dirt, any items in excess of 50 pounds, unsecured bundles of material that are unsafe for collection or anything over 4 feet in length.

### RECYCLING GUIDELINES

*Republic Services will be providing you a green 65-gallon recycling cart to place and store your recyclables for collection day. Set your recycling material at the curb, next to your trash on the regular collection day in your area. It is only necessary to place your recyclables out at the curb when your container is full. Most of the time, this can be done every other week.*

Bulk material (brush, tree or shrub trimmings including Christmas trees, board, fencing, paneling, carpeting, etc.) shall be cut in 4' lengths and tied in 18" bundles, weighing not more than 50 pounds. Small shrubs will be picked up in one piece if they are within the specified limitations. Loose material must be bagged, boxed, or placed in trash cans, and is also subject to the above weight restrictions.

Furniture and/or appliances or other listed items shall be picked up on the regular collection day. Picnic tables, chairs, and benches are considered furniture. For more information on bulk pricing please see the reverse side of this brochure.

### Follow These Simple Recycling Steps

Collect your GLASS, PLASTIC & METAL recyclables and place them together in your bin.

#### GLASS

All food and beverage containers made of glass can be recycled, regardless of color. Simply remove the cap, rinse them and place in the bin. No need to remove labels. Please, no herbicide or pesticide containers, window glass, light bulbs, mirrors or ceramics.

#### PLASTIC

All Food and Beverage containers and other plastics with the #1 thru #7 printed on the bottom can be recycled. Again, please rinse and place in your bin. Motor oil, antifreeze, pesticide and herbicide containers should be placed in your trash when empty.

### ALUMINUM AND STEEL CANS

Rinse all metal food and beverage containers and place them in your bin. Removing labels is not required. For added space in your cart, consider cutting tops and bottoms out and flattening the cans.

### NEWSPAPER AND OLD CORRUGATED CONTAINERS (OCC)

Newspapers should be placed in brown paper bags to contain them from blowing on collection day. Old corrugated containers (OCC) should be cut down to fit in the cart. If you're placing it outside the cart, after cutting it down into squares, secure with a string or masking tape. OCC or cardboard that is lined with foil, plastic, wax coated, soiled or wet should be **included with the your trash** as these types of materials will contaminate the good paper products. Other items that should be excluded from your recyclables are food service paper, cups plates and cereal boxes.

***\*If your trash service falls on or after a holiday, during the week, your collection will be delayed one day. Should one of these holidays fall on a Saturday or Sunday, all collections will be performed on the normal collection day, without delay.***
